- > The Kursaal Theatre hosts the graduation ceremony of 313 students from the 2015 class. Valentí Oviedo, manager of the Auditorium, reads the farewell lecture, entitled "Follow the yellow brick road on the way to the land of Oz".
- > The seventh edition of the Days of Educational Dialogue coincides with the launch of Lab 0_6 (a centre focused on the discovery, research and documentation of science education at an early age) and is dedicated to the passion for science and the emotion generated by the process of research and learning. The conference was attended by experts in science education such as Anna Forés, Neus Sanmartí and Carme Alemany and the scientific writer, Marc Boada.
- > The Faculty of Healthcare
 Sciences of Manresa offers the
 possibility of combining studies
 in Podiatry and Physiotherapy
 so that both degrees can be
 accomplished in five and a half
 years. It is the first offer of its
 kind in Catalonia with these two
 degrees, which takes advantage
 of the complementarity of the
 two healthcare specialties in
 order to produce professionals
 with a profile that is especially
 valued in the field of sport
 medicine.
- > The actor and singer Bruno Oro closed the second edition of the Business Studies Day aimed at 2nd of baccalaureate and CFGS students with the conference "Reinvent yourself to keep going."

- > The employment of graduates from the Fundació Universitària del Bages is 92%, according to a study on the incorporation into the job market of the first class of graduates in Early Childhood Studies, Business Management, Physiotherapy, Nursing, Speech Therapy and Podiatry. The data highlights that 100% of Speech Therapy and Nursing graduates who work, do so in a job which is completely related to their studies.
- > The Escorxador courtyard, located behind the FUB2 building, hosts the fifth edition of the Fair of Experimentation for children aged from 0 to 6 years old, an initiative from the Early Childhood Studies and the Faculty of Social Sciences in Manresa. The main novelty of this edition is that, along with the Rotary Club Manresa-Bages, UManresa announces a pilot test in the form of a prize to recognise scientific educational proposals aimed at children in infant and primary school which have been developed by teachers of schools and kindergartens in the Bages region.
- > The speech therapist, Mònica Ballester organises a day dedicated to holistic and preventive Speech Therapy in the framework of the commemoration of the European Day of Speech Therapy.
- > Business studies dedicate their annual cycle of conferences to reflect on "The economy and the company of the new Catalonia". It includes three sessions by José María Gay de Liébana, Oriol Amat and Joan Iglésias.

- > 22 people are students of the third edition of the Master's degree in orofacial motor functions which, for the first time takes place in Barcelona, at the premises of the Consortium Training Union in the Pere Virgili Healthcare Park. It is an international course for obtaining a double Master's degree from the University of UVic-UCC and post-graduate degree from the IEPAP in Portugal.
- > The Master's Degree in Outof-Hospital Emergency Care was taught for the first time in Majorca at the premises of SAMU 061 in the Balearic Islands. The programme, with a long history in UManresa, has a total of 26 students in the Balearic Islands.
- > The Fundació Universitària del Bages and the Healthcare Foundation of Manresa organised together with the Municipality of Santiago de Chile and the Inter-American Development Bank, the seminar "Dependency, chronic conditions and health care: lessons and challenges". The seminar, held in the Chilean capital, aims to help health professionals and social services of that South American country to think about management models in the provision of health and social services and dependency care in order to define a policy in this area in their country. Experts such as Marco Inzitari and Manel Peiró and the CEOs of the FSSM and FUB. Manel Valls and Valentí Martínez took part in the seminar as speakers.
- > The Fundació Universitària del Bages and the "Antigues Caixes Catalanes" Foundation signed a cooperation agreement that has as a main purpose to help professionalize the management of associations and foundations. To this end, the International Centre of Lifelong learning of the UVic-UCC Campus of Manresa, with the collaboration of the Foundation, has designed a Postgraduate Diploma in Management of Foundations and Associations, to be launched during the 2016-2017 academic year.

- > The Economist José María
 Gay de Liébana advocated the
 second edition of the Master's
 in Business Administration
 (MBA) at the UVic-UCC,
 consisting of 21 students.
 In his farewell lecture, entitled
 "Economic Challenges of the
 new Government of Spain", the
 advocate speaks to participants
 of the macroeconomic
 imbalances between Spain
 and Catalonia.
- > Nilda Pergallo, Dean of the School of Nursing and Healthcare Studies of the University of Miami, visits the facilities of the University Clinic and CISARC and meets the Director of Exchanges at the University of UManresa. Ms Pergallo also gave a talk entitled "UMiami-UManresa: connecting professionalism in clinical simulation".
- > The CISARC facilities host the second edition of Advanced Dental Implant Surgery course, organised jointly with the company Avinent Implant System. The course aims to train students so that they can apply sinus elevation treatments. immediate implants, plastic surgery applied to implants and techniques of guided bone regeneration in their daily practice, providing thereby a comprehensive service from the point of view of advanced dental implant surgery and implant aesthetics.
- > The Manresa campus of the International Centre for Lifelong Learning launched the first postgraduate programme in Clinical Simulation and teaching Innovation for health professionals. 15 people are following this programme based on learning processes that apply simulation methodology to enhance clinical, interpersonal communication, conflict resolution and uncertainty management skills.

The increase in international students fosters the need for courses in Catalan and Spanish

The translation service consolidates its functions with translation jobs both from inside and outside the university

- > The UManresa Language Service has increased its number of students and the variety of courses offered. Much of the growth is related to the increase in tailor-made in-company courses.
- > The Language Service
 has launched a blog in order to
 complement language learning
 and knowledge in a dynamic
 and attractive manner. In
 addition to articles, it includes
 content covering vocabulary,
 quotes from well-known people
 in the English-speaking world,
 expressions, tongue twisters to
 practise pronunciation, riddles,
 grammar and phrases and
 useful holiday expressions,
 among others.
- > The Language Service organises a workshop on recruitment addressed to companies. Enric Bastardes participates who introduces participants to support digital tools to attract talent. It also includes a simulation workshop on how to identify language skills in the selection process.
- > 79 students, mainly French ones but also Belgians, took part in the adaptation programme for international students prior to the start of the academic year. Its main objective is to familiarise students with the university environment. For two weeks, new students received tailored language lessons which are aimed at facilitating comprehension during the first days of class and got to know the range of sport organisations and clubs in the city.
- > The Language Service has organised a haiku contest, coinciding with Saint George's Day. A total of 173 language service students have taken part with poems in English and Japanese. All of the entries can be seen in an exhibition in the lobby of the main building of the FUB.

More collaboration agreements with european universities. More exchange students on the Erasmus Programme

- > Doris Sequeira, coordinator of the "Health Network of the Older Adult" (REDESAM) of Chile, visited the facilities of UManresa and the University Clinic. Ms Sequeira is a nurse and doctor in Social Gerontology. She collaborates in various projects of the Fundació Universitària del Bages and the Healthcare Foundation of Manresa, notably the organisation of the Congress on Chronic conditions, Dependence and Healthcare held in Santiago de Chile.
- > The Chilean Neurologist, Pedro Chaná, president of the Corporation of the Movement Disorders Centre (CETRAM) in Chile visited the facilities of UManresa and the University Clinic, with the objective of establishing a relationship of cooperation in the field of research and lifelong learning of health professionals.
- > The UManresa Business Studies professor and Doctor of Economics. Jordi Franch. is taking part in a teacher exchange with the University of Nürtingen-Geislingen (Germany). Franch is teaching at the two campuses of the university, with interventions on "Institutional corruption in Spain and the case of Catalonia. Situation and solutions; Europe recovery: Austerity or Monetary and Fiscal stimulus?": and "Inflation or Deflation: What is to fear?".

- > The Professor of Physiotherapy at the Lathi University of Applied Sciences in Finland. Paula Harmokivi. is presently teaching at the UManresa-FUB within the framework of the Erasmus teacher mobility programme. During her stay, Harmokivi has given lectures to the Physiotherapy students, visited the CU+ simulation facilities, presented her doctoral thesis to the Physiotherapy teachers and exchanged experiences regarding research topics with other members of the university teaching staff.
- > A delegation of six people from the University Hospital and University of Leuven (Belgium) have visited the UManresa and University Clinic (CU+) premises to learn how clinical simulation is used for teaching in Health Sciences studies. These contacts with the Belgian hospital and university are also useful to explore possible student exchange agreements between both universities either through the Erasmus programme or through direct agreements between the institutions.
- > A delegation from the
 Nursing studies faculty has
 visited the School of Nursing &
 Health Studies in the University
 of Miami. The objective of the
 visit is to give continuity and
 strengthen exchanges
 between the two universities
 and introduce them at the
 new International Centre of
 Clinical Simulation and High
 Performance (CISARC).

Explaining its mission regarding didactic resources and applied research to teachers and families has been the main objective of the Lab 0_6 during its first months of life

Close to 2,000 children have visited the Lab 0_6 in just six months

> The Early Childhood Studies of UManresa set up the Lab 0_6; a space designed so that children between the ages of 0 and 6 could come into contact with science in a natural way as well as promoting investigation and applied research in the world of teaching with regard to science education at an early age. Located in the FUB2 building (Avenue of the Bases, 1), the Lab 0_6 offers its first activity open to the public during the Christmas holidays: "Have a scientific Christmas".

> "Get hooked on Science" is
the proposal of the Lab 0_6 for
children aged from 3 to 8 for
the first week of September, just
before school starts again. It is
a science campus that aims
to cultivate the curiosity of
children for science by
encouraging them to ask
questions and to get involved
with scientific experiments
by means of the activities
organised by the Lab 0_6. The
campus seeks to promote

children's free time activities that are both educational and fun by combining games with learning.

> Around twenty people took part in the Research Day "The game of Science and Knowledge", included in the programme of the International Workshop in Higher Education 2016 of the UVic-UCC. During the event, held at the Lab 0_6, experiences were shared related to the topic of science for children. The first speech was given by Alessandro Porcheddu, from the Giocheria Laboratory of Milan, who talked about his experience in the field of informal education. Then Gabriel Lemkow, Professor of Early Childhood Studies of UManresa explained the function and objectives of the Lab 0_6. Finally, Jasone Latorre, from the Encis cooperative presented his experience of promoting creativity using recycled materials.

THE CU+ EXPANDS ITS PREVENTIVE CARE PROGRAMME TO COMPANIES

The interdisciplinary work of the specialised units offers new possibilities of primary and preventive health care of the CU+

New collaboration agreements with local companies and institutions make CU+ care activities available to groups with specific needs

- > The singing voice centres the third edition of the Health of Musicians and Performing Arts Day, an initiative promoted by Mutual Intercomarcal and Prevint, and organised jointly with the Manresa Campus of the UVic-UCC. The event features the singer and speech therapist, Nina, who offers the Master Class entitled "Voice Athletes".
- > The University Clinic (CU+) advises the company DENSO to help employees use the canteen service in order to improve their eating habits. This advice comes about after medical checks detected a high number of cases of workers who were obese or overweight or had high cholesterol levels, among other issues. Moreover, workshops focusing on healthy physical activity and ergonomics adapted to different jobs were also carried out.
- > 19 singers in the Manresa choir and 18 of the Manresa Musical Theatre participated in a physical examination in the University Clinic in order to diagnose voice disorders in people who use their voice intensely, and if there were any problems, to establish the most appropriate treatment. Two speech therapists from the voice department, Núria Carmona and Assum Linares, specialising in the spoken and sung voice, carried this out in order to provide a detailed personalised report for each patient.

- > The University Clinic renews its agreement with the Solsonès Health Centre for the provision of Speech Therapy in the public health system in this region.
- > The program Fifty-Fifty of the SHE Foundation for the prevention of cardiovascular disease counts on the support of the University Clinic for data collection and monitoring of participants.
- > The network of institutional relations of the University Clinic expands with the signing of new agreements with La Caixa Foundation, the entity providing dependency services, EULEN, the School of Performing Arts, Manresa Musical Theatre and the sports complex of the Manresa municipal swimming pools.
- > The University Clinic joins the CaixaProinfància programme as a service provider of Speech Therapy and Physiotherapy in its fight against poverty and social exclusion.

- > Science is the backbone around which the various proposals for reflection and discussion revolve of the first cycle of conferences organised by the Association of Senior Professionals at the service of the region, Gest!, the CTM Technology Centre - Eurecat and the three university centres of the city, the Fundació Universitària del Bages -UManresa, the Polytechnic School of Engineering of Manresa and the delegation of the Open University of Catalonia in Manresa. This joint initiative called 3Ct (Science, Culture, Knowledge and Talent), aims to bring academic university life closer to the town, with an informative yet friendly tone. The various institutions involved share a strong commitment in the generation and dissemination of knowledge and a dedication to service closely linked to Manresa and the whole of Central Catalonia as a natural sphere of its activity.
- > The Children's Campus of UManresa reaches its fifth edition with two new features: firstly, the transfer of the activities to the FUB2 building and, secondly, the inclusion of ideas related to science and experimentation.

- > 34 students on the Master's Degree in Out-of-Hospital Emergency Care and the course on Accidents concerning Multiple Victims and Disasters of UManresa participated in the mock accident organised to mark the 150th anniversary of the Local Police of Manresa. The drill, which involves an accident between two vehicles, mobilised more than one hundred people of the different security and health emergency bodies in the region. It included the assistance of a medical helicopter that simulated the evacuation of the critically wounded.
- > The differences and similarities between Andorra and Manresa in the 1960s and 1970s is the aim of the meeting between forty students from the Aula Magna of the University of Andorra and the FUB+GRAN programme of UManresa.

 The Andorrans were returning the visit that Manresa had made during the previous academic year.

THE HEALTHY AND CARING UNIVERSITY

- > The Healthy University
 programme of the FUB and
 the Town Hall of Manresa
 coordinate the fifth edition of
 Heart Week with educational
 and communication activities
 to promote healthy-heart living
 habits among the population.
 It includes a dozen proposals
 organised by a group of 25
 organisations, which start with
 a healthy walk and end with the
 walk around the Green Belt.
- > The UManresa facilities host the sixth edition of the University Blood Donation Marathon which closed with a total of 145 donations, of which 62 relate to people who gave blood for the first time.
- > The Fundació Universitària del Bages and Mútuacat organised for the second time the competition "Give it some heart", an initiative to support TV3's Marathon in the edition dedicated to metabolic diseases. "Give it some heart" aims to contribute to the Marathon through the recognition of artistic creations which serve at the same time to reflect on the need to acquire habits and activities that help to prevent diabetes and obesity and raise awareness of these diseases.
- > The Fundació Universitària del Bages supports "Giving Tuesday" or the global day of donations, a global initiative that wants to celebrate the solidarity of giving by mobilising the maximum number of individuals, families, organizations and businesses. The joining of the FUB in this initiative focuses on supporting a campaign promoted within the framework of this day, namely the Blood and Tissue Bank, which aims to get 1,000 new donors in Catalonia.
- > The Healthy University Week offers a programme of various activities to promote and publicise various lifestyle habits that promote health and wellness. The Week has the support of Manresan sports clubs: Cube & Duo; the Municipal Swimming pool; Vela Club Fitness and Gimbe, Llobet Group, the Town Hall of Manresa, Ca l'Arpellot, the Diputation of Barcelona, The Tennis Club of Manresa and the human tower group, "Peniats del Campus".
- > UManresa joins the commemoration of the Smoke-free Week to encourage people of the university community who smoke to have information and arguments to stop this toxic habit. For a whole week, positive messages about the benefits of giving up smoking are shared with the university community, CO breath monitors are used to calculate how smoke affects the lungs and a campaign of photos on Instagram is also launched.
